



EK Power Inc. Ice Etiquette

1. Purpose

To create a safe, respectful, and productive training environment, all skaters and their families must follow these guidelines. Please review them together before participating in any sessions.

2. Scope

- a. This policy applies to all participants, parents, guardians, and spectators attending sessions, and coaches.

3. Policy

a. Equipment

- i. Skaters must wear full hockey/ringette gear and must come with a hockey/ringette stick.

b. Parent/Guardian Expectations

- i. Skaters under 12 must have a parent or guardian present at the rink throughout the session.
- ii. To maintain a safe environment, parents and spectators must remain in designated viewing areas and are not permitted near the ice surface or in the hockey boxes.
- iii. Coaching or giving instructions from the stands is discouraged, as it can disrupt both the skaters and coaches. If you have concerns, please wait until after the session to discuss them with the coaches.

c. Skater Behaviour Expectations

- i. Roughhousing, chasing, shoving, or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- ii. Disruptive or inappropriate behavior—including excessive yelling, offensive language, and aggressive actions—will not be tolerated.
- iii. Any form of verbal or physical mistreatment directed at skaters, coaches, parents, volunteers, or rink personnel will result in immediate consequences.

Failing to adhere to these guidelines may result in removal from the session or program.
